### **Frontline Ministries**

Worship or Fellowship Umbrella? WMT members discussed the movement of Frontline Ministries to Fellowship and agreed that Frontline would stay under the Worship Ministry Team umbrella and stay in close cross communication with Fellowship Ministries. To facilitate greater depth in discussion, a ministry area may need to hold an additional meeting during the month. The three times a year "Vision Night" could be used to facilitate conversation with the all-inclusive worship ministry areas.

### **June is "Worship" core value month**

On June 3<sup>rd</sup>, pastors and WMT members (and hopefully elders) will begin meeting for prayer with Frontline and Media teams 15-20 minutes before the service begins. The intent is to pray for one another and for those they will come in contact with as they serve in ministry.

### **Summer Worship Services**

Curt is coordinating with Reed and Gordon regarding music leadership for the summer. Temple Choir will sing through June and then volunteer will assist with leading of hymns and special music during July and August. WMT agreed that guest music worship leaders would be asked to lead at all three morning services.
